ecosystems, cultivation of seaweeds and seaweed industry, aquaculture of marine invertebrates and integrated farming, molecular taxonomy and systematics.

This course has helped me to acquire knowledge specific on the molecular taxonomy and systematics of seaweed, algal-pathogen relationships and impact on the marine production of marine bioresources, natural product ecosystems, sustainable chemistry and biodiscovery, methods in plankton biology, quantitative genetics and selective breeding as well as tropical seaweed farming in Tanzania.
